**1. To agree the wording 'Alston Heritage Town' for brown tourist signs under the Rural Communities signage scheme for a sign at Hartside.**

The signs qualify under the Rural Communities signing criteria in the Cumbria County Council guidance, which also states that the '*The local town or parish council will be responsible for deciding the detail and content of individual rural community signing schemes*'.

A draft outline design for the new sign on the approach to Hartside been produced by the County, excluding the distance as this will be added when a decision has been made on the exact location.
