1. War Memorial

The chair reported that the meeting had been called to discuss a quote for correcting the misspelt name – Reginald Sparks, as the work if agreed would have to be carried out before the winter frosts, or left until the spring. John Glendinning had obtained costings from one firm and as of last week had not succeed in getting a quote from anyone else. However, over the last couple of days he obtained an estimate from a second company, but there is insufficient detail to be able to compare.

Once a quote is agreed the council will need to confirm with the War Memorials Trust that they are satisfied with the proposals.

Resolved to hold over a decision until the second quote specifies what work they intend to carry out. Proposed by Cllr English and seconded by Cllr Best. (8+ 1abs)

The clerk reported that John Glendinning has also asked about a price for cleaning the war memorial as just cleaning a small area will take a long time to weather in, and for a price for re-painting each letter. The war exhibition has closed now, but there may be some funds that could be donated towards these costs.
